**Paid Vacation:** Seven (7) days after 1 year of service or \$0.21 per hour; Twelve (12) days after 2 years of service or \$0.37 per hour; Fifteen (15) days after 8 years of service or \$0.46 per hour; Twenty (20) days after 15 years of service or \$0.61 per hour worked

**Paid Sick Leave:** Six (6) days per year after 6 months of service or \$0.18 per hour

**Straight-time Hours:** Eight (8) hours per day, five (5) consecutive days shall constitute a week's work.

**Recognized Holidays:**

New Years Day, Cesar Chavez Birthday (3/31), Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, Employee's Birthday, and Two (2) Floating Holidays.

**Overtime Rate:** All work performed on holidays, and in excess of eight (8) hours per day or forty (40) hours per week shall be paid at one and one-half times (1 ½ x) the basic straight-time hourly rate.

**Travel and Subsistence:** Employees required to furnish own vehicle between locations shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$0.25 per mile.

**Employer Payments:** (Public Utilities Code Section 465)

**Health & Welfare:** \$1.07 per hour worked

**Paid Holidays:** Six (6) holidays per year or \$0.17 per hour.

**Paid Vacation:** Five (5) days after 1 year of service or \$0.14 per hour; ten (10) days after 3 years of service or \$0.29 per hour, and Fifteen (15) days after 8 years of service or \$0.43 per hour.

**Paid Sick Leave:** One (1) day per year after 1 year of service or \$0.03 per hour

**Straight-time Hours:** Eight (8) per day, five (5) days work in seven (7) consecutive days constitutes a week's work.

**Recognized Holidays:**

New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day

**Overtime Rate:** All work performed on holidays, and in excess of eight (8) hours per day or forty (40) hours per week shall be paid at one and one-half times (1 1/2 x) the basic straight-time hourly rate.

**Travel and Subsistence:** Employees required to furnish own vehicle between locations shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$0.25 per mile.
